- iv. Prepare design, plan and estimation of various NRM structures.
- v. Ensuring AAP entry in MGNREGA portal of Priority Plan schemes and it's TS & AS approval (Technical Sanction & Administrative Sanction).
- vi. Provide lay out of the various NRM structures and monitor the works execution and timely completion.
- vii. Actively work to create social awareness about the rights and entitlements of MGNREGA.
- viii. Supervise the work of CCs and CRPs (Cluster coordinator and Cluster resource person) and provide them with hand-holding support at the village and Gram Panchayat level.
- ix. Capacity building of PRI members, MGNREGA Supervisors, Barefoot Technicians GRSs and project Cluster Coordinators (CCs) and Community Resource Persons (CRPs).
- x. Plan Farm based allied activities to ensure sustainable livelihood to poorest of the poor.
