Project Background and Context:

The Bharat Rural Livelihoods Foundation (BRLF), in collaboration with HDFC Parivartan, is implementing the Natural Resource Management Programme (FDP) across 25 villages in Peth Block, Nashik District, Maharashtra. This three-year initiative aims to double the income of at least 3,000 small and marginal (Tribal) households through sustainable, integrated development strategies tailored to the needs of tribal communities.

The project places a strong emphasis on Natural Resource Management (NRM), particularly Integrated Watershed Management, to improve soil and water conservation, agricultural productivity, and farm-based incomes. Key components include capacity building of communities, promotion of sustainable agriculture and horticulture, irrigation development, and the strengthening of community-based organizations (CBOs). The project also seeks to leverage government flagship schemes through convergence, fostering long-term sustainability and resilience in the Peth Block of Nashik District in Maharashtra State.

In lieu of this, BRLF invites Request for Quotation (RFQ) from Critical Input Vendors. The details of the scope of work and general terms and conditions are given below:

Scope of Work (SoW) for purchase of critical inputs:

The selected vendor will be responsible for the following:

- The work involves the procurement of critical inputs in 25 villages as per Annexure I.
- The rates of the particular will finalized for FY 2026-27.
- PO will be provided to vendor as per activity scheduled throughout the year.
- Transportation of all materials to one of the project villages including loading & unloading is required.
- Transport materials to site and ensure safe handling and storage
- The detailed procurement specifications is provided in Annexure I.

Submission of RFQ:

The RFQ must be submitted in two parts:

- i. Technical Proposal
 - ii. Financial Proposal (as per Annexure I)
- Submit proposals with all the technical documents and detailed cost breakdowns as per Annexure I and include a unit cost. Also, mention the rate of GST.
 - Brand/make other than Annexure quotation will be disqualified.

Pricing:

- The interested agencies would submit the financial bid only in the format annexed as Annex I
- Proposals should reflect cost for each component as specified in Annexure I.
- No other brand/make will be allowed.
- Payments will be made after the satisfied delivery.
- Final payment will be released after inspection and approval by the project team.
- BRLF reserves the right to define the payment schedule after selection of the agency.

Proposals that meet the mandatory requirements, as stated above, will be evaluated with the following criteria:

score assigned for the technical proposal is 30, and for the financial proposal is 70. BRLF reserves the right to call the shortlisted or selected agency or agencies for any queries if required.

The Agency with the highest score on the combined technical and financial bid would be selected for the award of the contract.

Shortlisted vendor or vendors at the technical proposal stage may be invited to present before the Evaluation Committee. Please note that only the shortlisted agency or agencies will be contacted.

- (ii) PAN Card, GST Registration, MSME and Income Tax Return for the last three years.
- (iii) Purchase Order/Work Order of similar assignments undertaken in the past five years.
